Christian Aid News of Nepal

Christian Aid emergency workers in Nepal are working with partner organisations to get relief through to the worst hit earthquake areas. They are providing tarpaulins, blankets, food and water purifying equipment and tablets. Christian Aid's Nepal Appeal has raised more than £1.2 million. The Disasters Emergency Committee, of which Christian Aid is a partner, has raised more than £50 million. The Moderator's Munro Challenge has raised £12,000.
