Useful Information



Eco-Tip

When cooking, ensure that the size of the saucepan matches the size of the hob ring you are using. This applies to both gas and electric cookers and means you are not paying (as much) to heat the air. Gas flames should only heat the bottom of the pan and not the sides. This will also help prolong the life of your saucepans.
