This Week's Eco Tip

See the light!

The high-tech components of LEDs mean they use at least 75% less energy than incandescent bulbs. As they are so efficient at conserving energy, they can help to reduce energy costs in your home. LED lights last 35 to 50 times longer than the traditional incandescent lights and up to 5 times longer than fluorescents. This means that even the most expensive of LED bulbs will end up paying for itself in energy savings throughout its lifetime.
