A Seasonal Eco-Tip

Bleed your radiators

Over time, air bubbles can gather in your radiator. The trapped air prevents the radiator from filling with water, which means it won't heat your home as efficiently and will lead to higher energy bills. If the top of your radiator is much cooler than the bottom, then it may need bleeding.
